Rules & Regulations of Science & Art Exhibition

1. The exhibit can be done individually or in group in any one of the topic given. A student can participate in both working & still model.
2. Each student or the group can only present one working and a still model.
3. Maximum four students can participate in a group for working models and maximum two students can participate in a group for still models.
4. For further details, if required, the students or parents can contact the respective class teachers.
5. Time allocated for presentation of the working model and still model is 2 to 3 minutes only.
6. The following criteria will be used for the judgement of the exhibits.
(i) Relevance of the topic (ii) Social usefulness (iii) Creativity (iv) Design and Methodology (v) Presentation
7. The exhibit should be explained and presented online
8. The description of the exhibit must be uploaded.

Rules and Regulations of Philately Exhibition

1. Stamps should be exhibited on A-4 size (22x 29 cm) album sheets with suitable description and history of stamp must be explained.
2. The stamps should be arranged on the album sheets facing them suitably so that there will be no congestion and kindly avoid the pasting of stamps on the paper.
3. The number of stamps in one page should not exceed more than 8.
