CIRCULAR

Dear Parent /Guardian,

We know that last year was tough, but we're excited to get back in the classroom this year. The government has declared the influenza pandemic is under control. We hope you and your family is keeping well at this time. After several months of remote teaching and learning, we are writing today to share some information with you about the plans that we are making for the safe return of our students to school. We would ask you to read this letter carefully as it outlines new and important protocols that will impact your ward and you as a parent/guardian in the coming year. We aim to make the return to school as positive and smooth as possible and we are very excited to welcome our students back to the school. The health and safety of students and teachers will remain our primary focus in these extraordinary times and we know that our students and teachers will work hard to reengage with coursework and make up for any ground lost.

Our school will reopen on 1st November 2021 after analyzing the reopening survey report.

At this time, students may safely return to class if they have no flu like symptoms. Because the flu can still affect others and can easily spread from person to person, please keep children who have flu like symptoms at home. Symptoms include: fever of more than 100 degrees and cough or sore throat. Don't send sick children to school – they will be excluded from class and sent home.

- Students should not arrive at school before 08:30 am each day and only by the entry assigned to them.
- Upon arrival, students must proceed to their allocated timetabled class room
- Doors of classrooms will be left open. Supervision will be provided in each zone from 08:30am.
- Students are encouraged to bring their own lunch and water each day.
- Students should not shake hands or hug their friends to prevent the spread of the virus
- Students should follow hand washing etiquette. Students must remain in their allocated class room at lunch time and break time. No sharing of food and other items (water, snacks etc.).

TRANSPORT

We are pleased to be transporting your child to and from school. We are very proud of the safety record of our school buses and the professionalism of our transportation team. But due to the constant diesel hike, and certain compulsory regulatory norms we are unfortunately forced to increase our bus fees .**BUS WILL RUN ONLY IF IT IS FEASIBLE**. This will be with effect from 1st of November 2021. Our request is to kindly stand by us otherwise the school would not be able to run the buses.

Re-opening the school safely will require the co-operation of all members of our whole school community; students, staff, parents/guardians. We want to assure all parents/guardians and students that plans and preparations are advancing well for the reopening of School. We are really looking forward in welcoming our students back to school and will be doing all that we can to ensure that the return to school is a safe and enjoyable experience.
